

# Full Circle Restorative Justice | 2025 Impact Summary

Full Circle Restorative Justice strengthens communities by helping youth, schools, and justice systems move from punishment to connection through restorative practices that build accountability, empathy, and belonging. We work alongside students, families, educators, and justice partners to prevent harm, repair relationships, and create pathways for young people to thrive.

This year, Full Circle Restorative Justice grew not just in reach, but in impact — expanding preventative work, elevating youth voice, strengthening partnerships, and increasing funding to ensure that more young people are met with connection, accountability, and hope instead of punishment.

This past year marked a powerful evolution for Full Circle Restorative Justice as we deepened our focus on prevention, connection-building, and youth voice across our communities. Key milestones included the launch of Own It, Change It Day and the development of Youth Impact Groups, expanding restorative practices in schools while strengthening partnerships with school districts and the 11th Judicial District Attorney's Office. We also grew our reach through expanded trainings, increased access to restorative practices for thousands of students, and renewed commitments in both Chaffee and Fremont counties. Together, these efforts reflect a shift from responding to harm toward cultivating belonging, accountability, and long-term resilience for the youth we serve. These along with increased funding set the groundwork for continued impact in the years ahead.
